Clue 2 (for 9 points)

The colour in the nickname of Izamal, a town in Mexico. (Yellow City)

Clue 3 (for 8 points)

Light visible between 575 and 594 nanonmetres. (yellow)

Clue 4 (for 7 points)

Shirts worn by the football club that plays its home games at the Plainmoor ground. (Torquay United)

Clue 5 (for 6 points)

The flag flown by a ship to indicate it has a disease on board and requires quarantine. (Yellow Jack)

Clue 6 (for 5 points)

The dot on a squash ball that means it has a low bounce and is therefore for advanced players. (yellow)

Clue 7 (for 4 points)

A ribbon referenced in the title of a 1949 film starring John Wayne. (She Wore a Yellow Ribbon)

Clue 8 (for 3 points)

The character Bumblebee in the Transformers franchise. (yellow)

Clue 9 (for 2 points)

The title of a song released by the band Coldplay in the year 2000. (Yellow)

Clue 10 (for 1 point)

The colour between orange and green in a rainbow. (yellow)
